Introduction

Imagine a traveler setting out on a summer hike—backpack loaded, map in hand, full of anticipation. The trail begins clear and marked, but as the sun climbs higher and distractions arise—a shortcut here, a scenic overlook there—it's easy to stray from the path. Without constant awareness and intention, even the most prepared hiker can drift off course. Our spiritual journey is much the same. As the days lengthen and our routines shift with vacations, activities, and warm-weather busyness, we can unintentionally wander from the steady trail of communion with God.

The psalmist wrote, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" (Psalm 119:105). God's Word is not just a guide—it's our compass, helping us navigate the twists and turns of life with wisdom and purpose. When we stay grounded in Scripture, we keep our bearings, even when the terrain becomes uncertain.

Author and pastor Eugene Peterson described discipleship as "a long obedience in the same direction." It's not flashy or hurried—it's steady, intentional, and deeply rooted in God's presence. Summer may invite a slower pace or more spontaneity, but it's also a rich opportunity to refocus, recalibrate, and walk closely with the One who leads us with kindness and clarity.

This Growth Guide is designed to be your trail companion for the season. With short Scripture readings, thoughtful questions, and space for prayer, each day is a chance to pause, breathe, and align your steps with Jesus. As you journey through the weeks ahead, may you find refreshment not just in sunny skies and open spaces, but in the quiet moments where God meets you—guiding, renewing, and drawing you deeper into his love.

Let this devotional keep you on the path, trusting that with each small step in his direction, you are being formed, nourished, and led toward the life he has prepared for you.



How to Use This Guide

Each daily entry in this guide contains an opening Call to Worship, a reading from Proverbs, a Scripture passage to read and meditate on, a couple of questions to think about, and an opportunity to talk with God (pray) about what you've read and heard. Here are a few thoughts to keep in mind:

We've designed these devotions to be flexible. If a daily devotion is a new experience for you, you might want to start by setting aside ten minutes a day to go through the material and pray. Don't worry too much about the length of time – it's better to spend a few minutes each day than to spend an hour every once in a while. And as time goes by and you get more comfortable, you may even find yourself naturally wanting to spend a little longer on each devotion.

If you miss a day, don't stress over it! Just pick up where you left off the next day. We've only given you five devotions per week, so you have a couple of extra "catch-up" days built into each week. And remember, this is meant to be a blessing, not a burden!

Many people find that picking a specific time and place to have their devotion each day helps them stay consistent. Remember – there's no "perfect" way to do this. Just find the time and place that works best for you where you can spend a few quiet, uninterrupted moments by yourself.

Each day, you might want to follow a basic order like this:

- Put away your phone or any other distractions. It may help to take a brief walk, light
  a candle, or stretch beforehand, as a way of easing your soul into a new mode of
  quietness and connection.
- Take a moment to sit quietly, recognizing that God is with you and loves you completely.
- Begin by saying a short prayer. Share anything you need or want to say to God,
   welcome his Spirit into this moment, and ask him to speak to you through his Word.
- Prayerfully read the Proverb of the day, then go through the main Scripture reading.
   Make sure to take your time and read slowly. You might want to read the passage several times. As you read, ask yourself: What do I notice about the passage? How might God be speaking to me today through these words?
- Spend a few moments reflecting on and answering the questions listed. Many people



find it helpful to jot down a few of their thoughts about the questions in the space provided. Taking a few notes has a way of helping us clarify what we're thinking, and it will also help you remember your experience better so you can share it with others.

Close by spending a few moments in prayer, submitting yourself to God and asking him
to make you more like Jesus. If you like, you can write out some or all of your prayer in
the space provided.

A Few Defails

This is the first time we've produced a summer Growth Guide, and the format is a bit different. Instead of a daily Psalm, we will read through Proverbs this summer.

Through June, the Scripture readings have been intentionally selected to complement the topics we'll be covering in the Sunday sermons. Each week, we focus on a particular theme that we'll explore more fully in the worship service that weekend. Often the text we read on Fridays will be the text for that coming Sunday's sermon. By reflecting on the theme throughout the week, you'll put yourself in a great position to hear from the Holy Spirit in worship on Sunday.

For the remainder of the summer, we will read through several epistles. While these will not correspond to the Sunday sermons (which are still being finalized as we go to print), they will give us continuity to explore several important New Testament themes and to grow in our understanding and practice of the way of Jesus as seen in the early church.

As you look through the readings, you'll notice that some days we give you a longer passage to read, but then we specify a few verses to focus on. On these days, we're including the longer reading to give you context, but encouraging you to focus specifically on the few verses that the questions will be based on. We suggest that you read the entire passage once, then read the verses to focus on several times. Note that you may read the longer passage several different days, while the verses to focus on will change each day. This gives you extended time to soak in a longer passage, concentrating on a bit at a time each day.

As before, we have included a section at the end of each week with more space for notes. You can use these in whatever way you find most helpful – extra space for your daily journaling, a place to write reflections and prayers for the days in between (like Saturdays or Sundays), or even to add a creative form of prayer such as drawing or writing a poem.



Additionally, we have provided a page where you can take notes from Sunday's sermon. You can then bring this book with you to your Grow Group to share reflections from your daily Growth Guide readings as well as from that week's message on the same theme. Use this space in whatever way serves you best.

A Final Word

As you walk through the pages to follow this summer, keep in mind: this guide isn't about obligation—it's about invitation. God longs to walk with you, to speak to you through his Word, to meet you in moments of stillness and reflection. He's not waiting for your perfection; he's simply inviting your presence.

Just like a hiker who stops to rest beside a bubbling stream or to take in a breathtaking view, each devotional moment is a chance to be refreshed, renewed, and reoriented. Not because you have to, but because you get to. Because the path of walking with Jesus is where joy, peace, and purpose truly flourish.

So don't worry about getting it all right. If you miss a day (or a few), just pick back up and keep walking. God is not keeping score—he's keeping step, patiently journeying with you.

May this summer be filled with moments where your heart is quieted, your soul is nourished, and your connection with God deepens. But don't stop there—let this time with him also fuel your growth, sharpen your purpose, and awaken your sense of mission. As you stay rooted in his presence, may you be empowered to love boldly, serve joyfully, and step into the good work he's already doing around you. God isn't just inviting you to rest in him—he's inviting you to join him in the renewal of the world. So walk with him, grow with him, and go with him. The journey is just beginning.
